CHRISTMASTIME IN WASHINGTON, DC & NEW YORK CITY

5 DAYS - 4 NIGHTS

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the itinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 Depart from Virginia and travel to Washington, DC to meet your guide for a guided driving tour of Washington which passes by Embassy Row and the magnificent National Cathedral (*which is the sixth largest church in the world and symbolizes our country's heritage of faith and religious freedom*). Next, visit the Hillwood Estate Museum and Gardens, the mansion of Marjorie Merriweather Post, which is beautifully decorated in Christmas grandeur. After lunch in the area, visit the U.S. Botanic Garden, one of the oldest botanic gardens in North America. This living plant museum was established by Congress in 1820 and is decorated with poinsettias for the holidays. Then, spend some time at the DC Christmas Markets at Penn Quarter which is all decked out for the holiday. Dinner is included this evening, followed by a stop at the National Christmas Tree and the Pathway of Peace in Ellipse Park across from the White House ... site of nightly choral performances, a Nativity scene, and a spectacular display of lighted Christmas trees representing each state and territory of the United States. End your day with an Illuminated Monument Tour. Return to your hotel after your tour.
- Day 2 Following a deluxe continental breakfast, check out and depart for New York City. Upon arrival you will proceed to busy Herald Square to shop and visit at one of New York City's most famous icons of shopping ... Macy's. There will be time to visit Rockefeller Center, New York City's historic landmark for dining and shopping in the heart of Midtown Manhattan. No trip to Rockefeller Center is complete without seeing the skating on the rink, one of New York City's most celebrated attractions. Set amid a sparkling scene featuring the annual Christmas Tree, it's something everyone should experience. There are many shops and other restaurants to visit in the area. Dinner has been arranged for you in Manhattan this evening. After dinner, check into your hotel for a three-night stay.
- Day 3 Following breakfast, board your motorcoach for Radio City Music Hall where you will enjoy a back door tour of the theater. Get behind the scenes of over 70 years of New York City history. See the great stage, the art deco interiors, the legendary Wurlitzer organ, and even meet the Rockettes themselves. After the tour, enjoy lunch on your own in the area and some shopping along Fifth Avenue. Later, you will visit the 9/11 Memorial Museum. Then, it's off to Radio City Music Hall to see the Christmas Spectacular featuring the world-famous Rockettes, who have been performing at Radio City since 1932. Dinner has been arranged for you this evening.
- Day 4 Enjoy breakfast, then meet your guide for a tour of Lower Manhattan which will encompass a diverse and exciting cityscape and a patchwork of distinct neighborhoods, including Times Square, Greenwich Village, Little Italy, Chinatown, Ground Zero, and the Financial District. Enjoy lunch on your own, then spend the rest of the afternoon and evening sightseeing on your own. Dinner is on your own in Manhattan.
- **Day 5** After breakfast, check out and depart for home with holiday memories of New York City and Washington, DC.
